

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

The highest standards of behaviour and commitment are expected of everyone participating in Centrestage activities. Lead staff reserve the right to remove students from the register who do not comply with this.

Students will be placed according to their abilities and to ensure that all participants get the most out of their classes.

After successful registration, students are committed to attend the full term, and should attend each week.

All classes (other than some adult classes) are payable termly in advance, either by cash, cheque or debit/credit card. The full Annual Fee may be paid by 10 standing order payments.

We must be notified in writing (or by completion of an amendment form) if you/your child wishes to withdraw from a class. Standing Order payments should not be cancelled until the balance of the term fees has been paid, or arrangements to do so by other means has been agreed by Centrestage. Fees will only be refunded on production of a medical certificate.

The only item of uniform required at Centrestage is the CS t-shirt. All participants of school age **MUST** wear the Centrestage t-shirt or polo shirt whilst taking part in activities. These can be ordered from the reception. Please note that school aged children who persistently attend classes without a Centrestage t-shirt will be removed from the register.

A nominal fee of £1 will be charged for each additional rehearsal outwith the normal timetable, payable on the day. For all participants involved in full-scale productions, a nominal fee will be charged for costumes.

Chewing gum is forbidden in any rehearsal or performance area and mobile phones must be switched off during class and rehearsal times.

In the course of classes, rehearsals and productions, photographs and video recordings may be taken.

If your child has any medical reason that may cause difficulty in their taking part, please speak to Fiona Robson, Fiona McKenzie or Paul Mathieson in order that measures can be taken to ensure their safe participation.

Centrestage Music Theatre reserve the right to refuse registration to any member of the public, or to remove any member from the register.
